Abstract: The Waldo Congregational Church was gathered in 1896 two years

after being founded as the Montello Mission. In 1980 the Waldo Congregational Church, First Parish Congregational Church, South Congregational Church, and Porter Congregational Church merged to form the Christ Congregational Church. This collection contains the administrative and membership records of the church and includes

record books, financial records, and vital member records.

Historical Note

The Waldo Congregational Church in Brockton was started in 1894 as the Montello Mission. The Montello Mission was administered by the Church Work Committee of the Porter Evangelical Church until 1896 when the mission was officially gathered as the Waldo Congregational Church. The parish met in the north of Brockton at the corner of North Main Street and Willow Street. In 1980 the Waldo Congregational Church, First Parish Congregational Church, South Congregational Church, and Porter Congregational Church merged to form the Christ Congregational Church. The old church building no longer exists.
