Abstract:	The Church of Christ was gathered on October 28, 1724 with Ebenezer Parkman, who served the church until his death, as its minister. In 1825 the church reformed as the First Congregational Society. This collection contains digital surrogates and a microfilm copy of the record book for the Church of Christ.

Historical Note

The town of Westborough was incorporated on November 19, 1717 and construction on the town's first meeting house completed in 1722. The Church of Christ was gathered on October 28, 1724 with Ebenezer Parkman as its minister. During the First Great Awakening, both George Whitefield and Johnathan Edwards preached at the Church of Christ. Construction began on a second meeting house in 1748, and the first service held there was on September 3, 1749. After 58 years as the church's minister, Ebenezer Parkman died on December 9, 1782. In 1825, shortly after the first train station opened in Westborough, the church reformed as the First Congregational Society.
