The series of letters from "Frank" to "Jim" were probably written by Frank Scribner (in the 1950s secretary of the Congregational Christian Church's Annuity Fund) to newly appointed Conference Superintendent James English. The three letters, compiled into a three-chapter monograph, address the challenges of serving as conference superintendent.

English gave the monograph to Nathanael Guptill in 1962 (a letter to that effect is with the monograph), and he in turn donated it to the Congregational Library at an unknown date. The work was stored in the library stacks until January 1993, when it was transferred to the archives.
